
FEEDBACK ANALYSIS REPORT 2020-21

ABOUT FEEDBACK

Maulana Mazharul Haque Teachers' Training College has been working on sustaining quality culture in the field of academic and administrative services. For this, the IQAC initiates the conduct of feedback from various stakeholders. During the academic year 2020-21, the formal and informal feedback was also collected from all the stakeholders and analyzed. In order to provide the quality education to the student community, we obtain the feedback from the graduating and post graduating students on various aspects of academic and administrative activities through three structured feedback proformas. The views and opinions of these students help in bringing the improvement in curriculum and different activities of the institution. College solicits the feedback from the passed-out alumni on important attributes of the institution during alumni meet and other similar re-union meetings. They are also invited to various functions and occasions organized by the institute. Their feedback is an important source of information for betterment and development of the institution. For the welfare of society, IQAC constantly does a quality check of educational services by getting feedback from the parents whose insights help to augment quality services as well as make the right decisions wherever necessary. Parent-Teacher Meet is organized in every year and a feedback session is conducted during the meet. Teacher educators' feedback involves accurate appraisal of the effectiveness of teaching of the interns during internship program and areas that need revision of curriculum. The Curriculum Development Cell of the institute also periodically collects feedback from the students regarding various aspects of the different courses running in the college. In order to meet the expectations of the schools and teacher education institutes, we get feedback from the employers and Principals of practicing schools that may help in bringing the change in course content of teacher education programs. For collecting informal and formal feedback from above mentioned stakeholders, the institute provides different platforms and has also designed feedback proformas on the various aspects of curriculum, infrastructure, faculty and facilities provided.

STUDENTS

The feedback of the students was taken on eight parameters of the course. The feedback analysis clearly indicates that majority of students rated high the depth of course content and extent of coverage of course. Most of the students found course having relevant learning values with its applicability to real life situations. Feedback analysis showed students' satisfactory attitude towards reference material provided by the teacher as well as available in the library.



Overall, the majority of students rated the course very good. However, some students requested for easy accessibility of textual reading material during COVID-19 Pandemic. Some Post graduate students faced difficulty in data collection for their dissertation and undertaking experimental studies.


EMPLOYER


Overall Student Feedback Analysis:

Overall Feedback Analysis:


